

TRANSPORTABLE AND SUSTAINABLE

A recent study by independent building research and testing company, BRANZ, found that transportable homes had a far lower environmental impact than traditional onsite construction. The study found prefabricated buildings, including transportable homes such as those built by Keith Hay Homes, had significantly reduced greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions thanks largely to a reduction in waste.
